

Divided Roll Basket:



Materials:



Black/White basket:

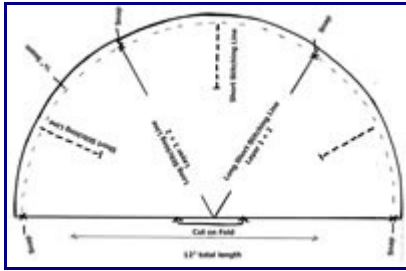
- ½ yd. of each (black and white) pre-washed fabric
- 3 ½ yds. Rick rack
- Thread to match
- 3 sets of small snaps
- Water soluble marking pen or tailors chalk

Toile basket:

- ¾ yd. (60" wide) decorator fabric (toile) pre-washed
- 5" piece of fabric to cover snaps
- Thread to match
- 3 sets of small snaps
- Water soluble pen or tailors chalk

Cutting and Marking:

1. Cut out six 12" circles using pattern provided. If making the Black/White basket, cut 3 circles from each fabric.



2. For basket w/ rick rack:
 1. Pin rick rack to 3 circles (fabric is right side up).



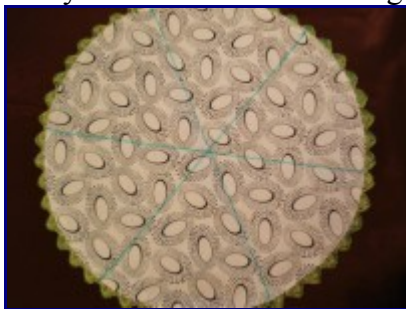
2. Using a 1/8" seam allowance, stitch around entire circle attaching rick rack.
 3. Repeat for remaining circles.
3. Lay circles right sides together (Black against White) or (Toile against Toile) and pin. Mark a 4" opening on each of your 3 circle sets.



4. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew around each circle stopping (and back stitching) at opening. Repeat for remaining circles.
 5. Turn circles right side out and press. Topstitch 1/8" to the edge around each circle.



6. Label each set of circles (layer 1, 2, 3). Set circle layers 2 +3 aside.
7. Using washable marking pen or chalk mark long stitching line and snap placement to one side of layer 1. Mark short stitching line to other side of layer 1 circle.



8. Place layer 1 (markings face up) on top of layer 2. Pin to secure in place. Stitch along the long stitch line markings. Be sure to backstitch at each edge.



9. Flip over sewn circle. Layer 2 will now be on top. Place layer 1 + 2 on top of layer 3. If you lift up a section of layer 2 you should be able to see the short stitch line markings. Stitch together layer 2 + 3 along marking lines, being careful not to catch layer 1. Backstitch at beginning and end of stitching line.



10. Flip over sewn circles. Layer 3 will now be on top. Using markings from layer 1, transfer snap placement from layer 1 to layer 3.



11. Attach alternating snap sides to each mark around the circle.



12. Join snaps together to build basket. Enjoy!
