Scrappy Jane Austen Quilt Border (no 2 of the same fabrics will touch!)

1. Divide your 20 border fabrics into 10 for group A, and 10 for group B. Once you put a fabric into a group, don't switch it.

2. Cut all fabric 2" high by width of fabric. Sew 3 different strip sets for each group that are 3-fabrics high, all in different fabrics.

3. Cut strip sets 2" wide.

5. Add 2" square sashing border to one end of 64 A columns and to one end of 32 B columns.

6. Press all A columns toward the sashing square (center of quilt). Press all B columns away from the sashing square.

7. Arrange border units, offsetting one square each, in A-B-A columns, all with sashing square to one end. Make half left-handed,and half right handed.


8. Remaining B columns will be attached to long sashing between rows when assembling the quilt top.

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4. Attach 3 strip sets, all A or B fabric (don't mix), end to end to make 9-high columns.



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
