## Fall Fun Projects

Fall is one of the most popular decorating seasons of the year! Let's make an easy fall leaves garland, a fall banner and add applique embellishments to purchased items to celebrate!

### Supply List:

Accuquilt Dies Used: Rustling Leaves 1, 2 and 3  
Fall Medley

### Fall Leaves Garland:

Scrap fabric in leaf colors  
Fusible web  
Ribbon

### Fall Banner:

1/2 yard cut into (6) 5" x 16" rectangles  
1/8th yard for letters  
(2) 5" squares for pumpkins  
Fusible web: (6) 5" x 7" rectangles  
(2) 5" squares  
Letters  
Ribbon or rick rack

### Tea Towel:

(1) 6" x wof strip fabric for ruffle  
(1) 5" x wof strip fabric for ruffle  
(1) strip 2 1/4" x width of towel plus 1/2"  
fabric for applique shape  
fusible web  
purchased tea towel

### Fall Napkins:

Purchased napkin set  
fabric for applique shapes  
fusible web  
optional - covered button kit
