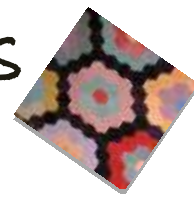




# Sew'n Wild Oaks

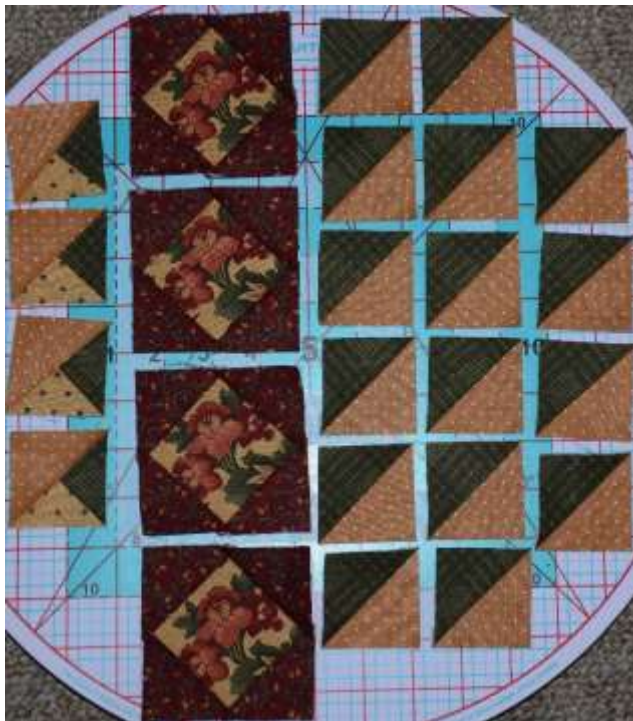

## **BLOCK #3**

**9" Block**



Block #3 is made from the following components. (4) Y-Squares, (16) Half-Square Triangles and (4) Squares in a square



Variations using the same components. There isn't a single triangle in this whole block even though it looks like is it full of them. Pay close attention to the way the pinwheels are spinning. It is easy to get confused. I stitched all of my pinwheels together, and then assembled the rest of the components.



**Y-Squares – Make (8) – You will have (4) leftover Y-Squares – Directions on Page #8**

✂ (2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares for piece A - from light fabric

✂ (2)  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{4}$ " squares for piece B - from dark fabric

✂ (4)  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares for piece C – from medium fabric

♥ **Trim to 2" x 2"**

♥ Finished size will be  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

**Half-Square Triangles – Make (16) Directions on Directions on Page #4**

✂ (2) 5" x 5" squares – (1) dark and (1) light

♥ **Trim to 2" x 2"**

♥ Finished size will be  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ "

**Square in a square – Make (4) – Directions on Page #12**

✂ (4)  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{5}{8}$ " fussy cut a nice center or base square

✂ (8)  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " squares from a contrasting color for corners

♥ **Trim to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "**
